B: How much is a ticket?

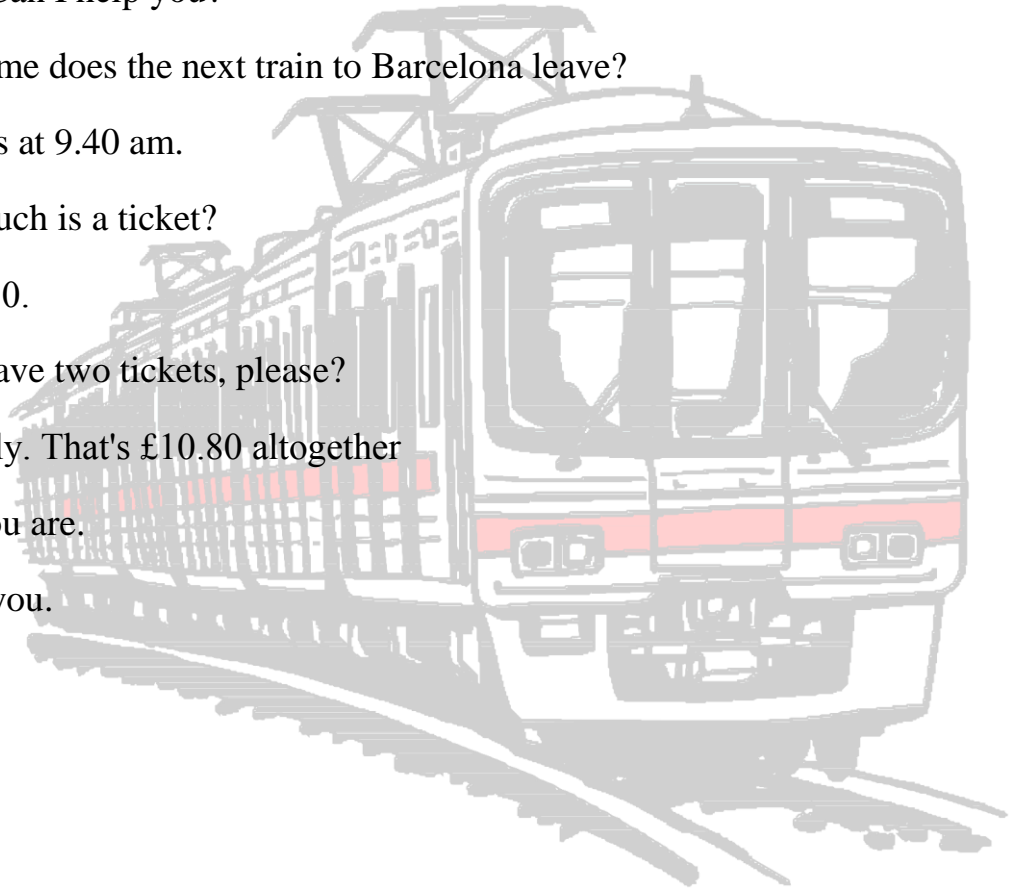
A: It's £5.30.

B: Can I have two tickets, please?

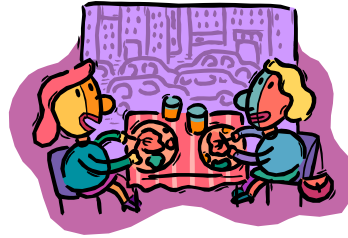
A: Certainly. That's £10.80 altogether

LATER

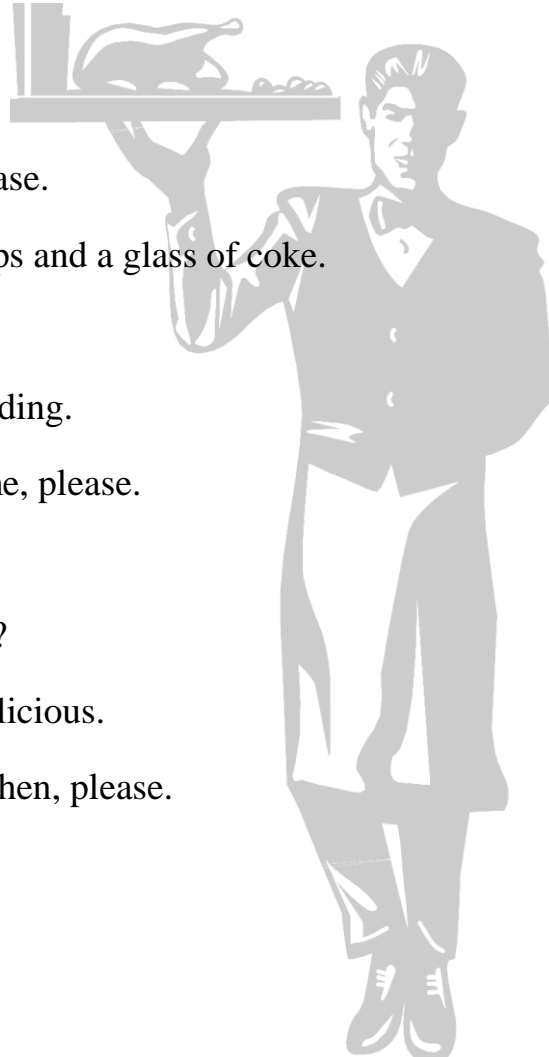
Waiter: Did you enjoy your meal?
